1. Tour of locations along Phase 1 and Phase 2 sections of the new levee construction zones, and other areas time permitting.

The United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) and Reclamation District 2140 (RD 2140) are hosting a tour of the Hamilton City Flood Damage Reduction and Ecosystem Restoration Project area (The Hamilton City Levee) on Friday, September 16, 2016, at 11 a.m. The initial meeting point and briefing is at the Hamilton City Fire Station, 420 1st Street, Hamilton City, California. Personnel from the USACE Sacramento District will accompany the group.

Travel to the tour site from the H.C. Fire Station. (Note: Transportation for the general public, to or from the tour site, will not be provided by RD 2140 or USACE).

It is anticipated the tour will last about 1-2 hours depending on the number of stops made along the construction route.
